

## **Credit module «International trade»**

*Subject:* methodology for finding optimal international economic relations in terms of legal and political regulation of international trade relations.

*Aim:* familiarize students with the theoretical foundations of international trade and trade policy, the basic concepts of the international movement of goods and services, especially the participation of different countries in the international division of labor, the role and impact of international trade mechanism for national economic development, the regulation of international trade and its institutions.
