## Commercial law

**Commercial law** - a body of law regulating social relations in the organization and implementation of economic activity between entities and between these entities and other participants of economic relations.

The subject of Commercial law is any economic activity, production and sale of goods, works and services for profit or without such a purpose, which is implemented in Ukraine business entities of all types and forms of ownership and activities of state bodies on economic management.

Economic law is a complex branch of law which is based on civil law on the standing of natural and legal persons, property rights, civil contracts and specifies them, and also contains the rules of administrative, financial, labor law governing economic activity. That is, in this area of law combined economic and organizational elements.

The purpose of discipline is to develop the students' knowledge of legal systems, intrinsically related management activities; mastering theoretical knowledge and practical skills related to the legal regulation of economic activity, the legal status of business entities and government bodies.

Tasks of the course is aimed at:

- Mastering the rules of economic legislation;
- Study the nature of different scientific schools;
- To develop the students' scientific approach to the assessment of current economic law, the need to improve its legal regulation of economic activity;
- The acquisition of skills with the regulatory material;
- The ability to solve specific business situation at the national and international law; Development of legal thinking on the implementation of the economic rights in the chosen field;

sense of responsibility in the implementation of legally significant actions.

Of the course is to develop the creative skills of participants processes, compliance of their actions with current legislation, the use of basic knowledge of business law in the economy of the company, management, marketing, operations in the foreign exchange and stock market foreign trade.
